Routes:

'A' Hard route for the experienced regular rider.

'B' Easy route suitable 50's machines & clubman riders'

'C' Very easy route for pre-war & rigid machines & gentleman riders.

Classes:

1. Pre 1970 unit four stroke.

2. Pre-unit & four stroke twins.

3. Pre 1970 two stroke.

4. Rigid.

5. Gentleman on any of the above machines riding the 'C' route.

6. Specials – highly modified machines i.e. replica frames which do not follow original form, two strokes with reed valves fitted, Japanese forks or carburettors. Please be honest as the club will ask entrants to ride in this class if it deems the machine does not fit the spirit of the period. We are a **Classic Club** and want to encourage the use of original machines.

Marking:

Will be the traditional 50's/60's system i.e. 1, 3, 5 non stop, 1 for a dab 3 for 2 dabs or footing, 5 for a stop or deviating outside designated route or touching a marker, 10 for missing a section. Riders will be deemed to have entered a section when the front wheel spindle passes the begins cards & finished when it passes the end cards.
